

**CHARLIE'S NEVERSINK CADDIS:**

Hook: Tiemco 100BL, Standard Dry

Size: 14, 16, 18

Thread: Black, Ultra Thread 70 denier

Abdomen: Thin Fly Foam: black, Olive, Brown

Wing: Blue dun polypropylene or para post and  
add a couple strands of crystal flash

Thorax: Black Dubbing

Hackle: Grizzly

Place the hook in your vice and begin wrapping the thread just behind the hook eye and continue to the hook bend. Take your fly foam and cut a thin, long strip. Tie it in at the bend of the hook and wrap tightly 2/3 of the way up the hook shank and tie off. Cut the excess foam off by streaking it first. Take your wing material and depending on the size of the hook, tie it on top of the hook straight or double it first for a larger wing.

Take your hackle and after stripping off the first few barbs, tie it in just in front of the wing. Now dub a short section of thread and wrap a tight head. Next wrap the hackle tight around the head three-four times, tie off and cut away the excess. Tie off the fly and cement the head.

This fly floats very well and aside from wearing out the hackle with fish forever. In black it is a good choice for the Mother's Day Hatch.
