

Griffith's Gnat:

Hook: Standard dry fly; #16-24

Thread: Black, 8/0-12/0

Hackle: Grizzly, dry fly

Abdomen: Peacock herl

Wind the thread to where the bend in the hook begins. Tie in your hackle, which should be ½ the length of the hook gap. Mount a strand of peacock herl over the hackle mounting wrap as you would mount a collar hackle. The iridescent side of the herl should be facing down. Wind the herl forward to a point four thread wraps behind the hook eye. Tie off the herl and clip the excess. Spiral the hackle forward and tie off. Cement the head
